Bethany for Children & Families is celebrating 125 years of transforming the hearts and homes of the most vulnerable children, adults, and families in the greater Quad Cities area!

What began as an orphanage and just one baby boy has grown into a service agency that addresses child welfare, poverty, mental illness, domestic violence, parenting, sex education, homelessness, and much more through 37 programs and services.

Since its inception in 1899, Bethany has helped at-risk individuals and families navigate tough times through:

- 22 presidential administrations;
- World War I, World War II, Vietnam War, Gulf War, and Afghanistan War;
- The Great Depression and The Great Recession; and
- The Spanish flu, polio epidemic, AIDS/HIV epidemic, and COVID-19 pandemic.

Now located in its **seventh service center** at 1701 River Drive in Moline and through its **new affiliate**, **Bridgeview Community Mental Health Center in Clinton**, Iowa, Bethany continues the mission to keep children safe, strengthen families, and build healthy communities.

# **Program Spotlight: Adoption**

Bethany's first purpose in this community was to serve as an adoption agency for parents not able or not willing to care for newborns. While only **three infants were placed with adoptive parents in the past three years**, the program that served as the agency's foundation still exists.

Bethany is a licensed adoption agency in Illinois and child placement agency in Iowa. The agency offers domestic infant adoption and special needs adoption (for children older than one year who have been abused or neglected, have physical disabilities, or have behavior issues).

The decision to adopt a child is truly life-altering and requires a lifetime commitment. **Individuals considering adoption** go through a process including:

- A criminal background check and review of the child abuse registry;
- A home study;
- Numerous visits by a trained, professional, adoption worker;
- A review of the family's financial stability;
- Letters of reference; and
- Attendance at several preparation classes.

For those **considering placing a child for adoption**, Bethany provides free counseling to explore options.

### **MERIT Award Winner**

Our MERIT Award winner for January-March 2024 is **Clay Huffstutler**! Clay is the supervisor of Bethany's Therapeutic Recreational Program (TRP). Clay has a **30-year history** with the agency!

He began his career as a program coordinator for the Supportive Living Program. For the past 25 years, he has worked for TRP and has served as the program supervisor since 2007.



His nomination stated, "Clay has demonstrated he is responsible through his actions and words. He maintains responsibility for his actions or what he says and holds the kids accountable for their actions without demonstrating favoritism. He is a strong believer in treating the children equally including any times when they may violate a rule or make a mistake. He does not degrade the children or make them feel shame, but disciplines in a way that presents as a teaching moment. Clay tries not take anything they say personally and has encouraged coworkers to do the same."

TRP is an after-school program designed for boys and girls with serious emotional and behavioral problems which may lead to placement outside the home. It utilizes recreation and leisure activities as constructive and productive intervention tools. TRP is for at-risk youth ages eight to 17 years old. It helps youth and adolescents manage and reduce aggressive behaviors, improve social skills and moral reasoning, and build healthy relationships.

The "MERIT Employee of Distinction Award" recognizes an employee for his/ her distinguished service to the agency on a quarterly basis. This individual has displayed **M**otivation, **E**xcellence, **R**esponsibility, **I**ntegrity, and **T**eamwork in the execution of going beyond his/her job duty and responsibilities.


# **Capital Campaign Update**


